In 1869 when the name of "Hokkaido" was given to this ground- Descendants of Kojuro Katakura, known as the right-hand man of Japanese famous warrior Masamune Date, stood as a candidate for the migration and exploitation to the Noboribetsu area.

They exchanged their swords to hoes and overcame many difficulties in order to recover their pride lost in the disturbance of the Meiji Restoration, and to revive their beautiful vigorous hometown Sendai praised as "Northern Edo" into the northernmost wilderness.



These dreams of the pioneers give birth to "Another Edo" Noboribetsu Date Jidaimura in the present world.

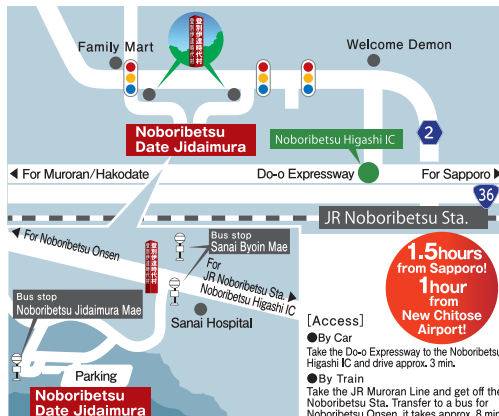
And a big entertainment space colored by powerful action and wonderful performance has expanded.

Take the Do-o Expressway to the Noboribetsu Higashi IC and drive approx. 3 min.
- By Train
Take the JR Muroran Line and get off the Noboribetsu Sta. Transfer to a bus for Noboribetsu Onsen, it takes approx. 8 min.

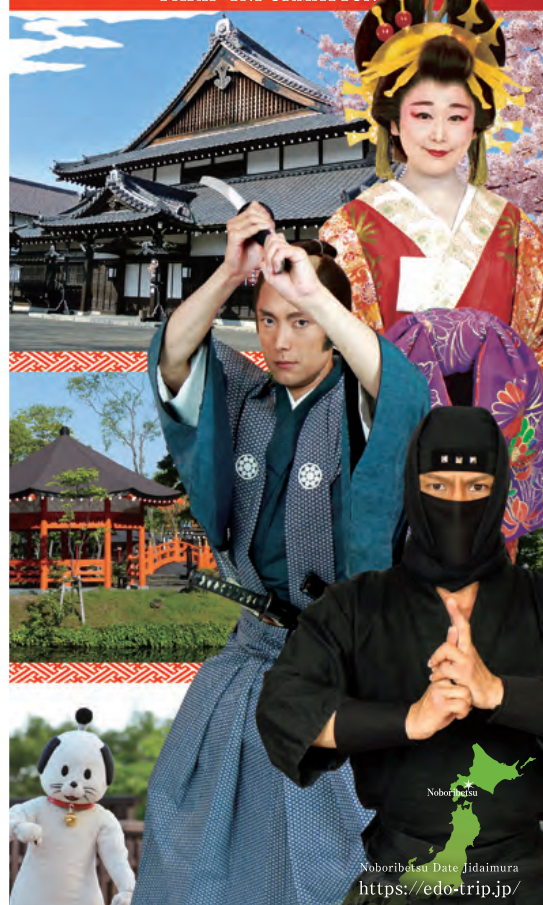
